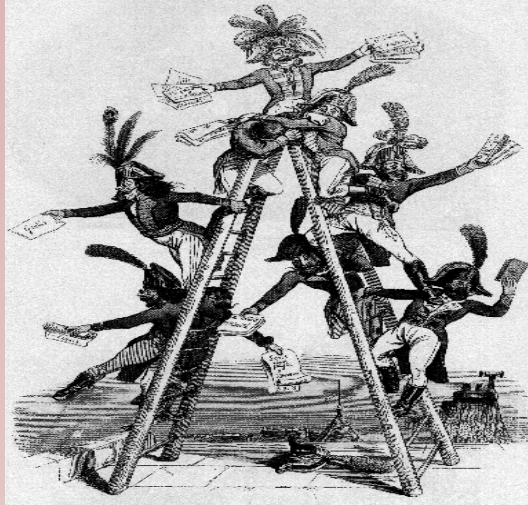


Western students are invited to: The 14th Annual Student History Conference
