## Hotel accommodation

A block of 25 rooms has been reserved for three nights at **Spencer Hall**: Thursday 15 October, Friday 16 October, and Saturday 17 October. When making your booking please mention the conference and Western: the special room rate is \$109 per night or \$119 to include breakfast (recommended as we won't have a breakfast buffet at the conference itself), plus tax. Check-in time is 4 pm, check-out time 12 noon. The rooms will be released back to the hotel on 15 September, so best to make a reservation over the summer.
