

Professor Kenneth Hilborn International Relations Internship Award

Two internship scholarships will be awarded annually to full-time students pursuing an Honors Specialization in International Relations in the Faculty of Social Science. These internships may be held within Canada or internationally. The Department of History will select the recipients based on academic achievement and the suitability of the internship opportunity. Applicants must have secured an internship opportunity with an organization that can provide hands-on experience related to the area of International Relations, and will be required to provide proof of the offer, terms, description of the organization, duration of the internship, and full contact information of the onsite supervisor. Students who have completed such an internship in the current or past academic year may apply retroactively. Applications are due on November 15th (for decisions in early January) and March 15th (for decisions in early May). Further application details are available from the Department of History. A committee designated by the Chair in History will select the recipients. Recipients of this scholarship will write a brief report about their internship experience for the IR website at the completion of their internship. Value : 2 at \$1,000
